

Prices for treatment undertaken between 1st August 2021 and 31st July 2022

Consultation

Our fertility specialist will prepare for your consultation by reviewing medical records and any tests already undertaken. They will gather remaining information in the appointment and letter will be sent to you outlining what was discussed and what plan has been put in place. The appointment will not be longer than 30 minutes and may be face to face or via video link. Any investigations and screening tests required will be discussed with you and arranged thereafter. We may have to ask you to attend a community-based centre for blood tests, this will reduce the number of visits required to the Centre.

Should you wish to commence treatment, you will be sent a link to electronic consents which you can complete in the comfort of your own home, and you may be given, a further consultation with medical staff followed by a consultation with a member of the nursing team alternatively you may only need a nurse appointment. The nurse appointment costs are included in the price list below.

Screening Tests

* Screen as required by HFEA (Code of Practice T50) Prior to Processing Eggs, Sperm or Embryo Testing for HIV 1+2, anti-HIV 1+2, Hepatitis B (HBsAg and Anti HBC and Hepatitis C (Anti HCV-Ab) must be undertaken within 3 months of treatment. Other tests may also be required e.g. HTLV and CMV which will be discussed on an individual basis. You will be provided with further information regarding the tests and also a consent form for you to consider and complete before the test is requested and an invoice raised.

Medication

All medication required for your treatment cycle is prescribed by medical staff involved in your care. Medication is provided when you attend the Centre prior to treatment commencing. For fresh IVF/ICSI cycles, you will receive a 10-day supply, with additional medication provided when and as required, which must be paid when provided. There is no charge for the hCG (trigger medication).

Please note medication provided for your treatment is cannot be returned and therefore costs cannot be refunded.

Should your cycle be cancelled before egg recovery you will receive a refund of £1,600

Should your cycle be cancelled after egg recovery but there are no embryos to transfer, you will receive a refund of £1,100.

Should all embryos be frozen due to the risk of hyperstimulation we will proceed with a Frozen Embryo Transfer cycle as soon as possible at no extra cost.

Frozen Replacement Cycle (FET)

If your FET is following a recent fresh cycle, then all information regarding the FET will be discussed with you. A link to relevant information and consent forms will be sent to be read and completed prior to a nurse consultation which is free of charge.

However if it has been some time since your previous treatment cycle you will need a consultation to update your medical history and to provide you with information regarding, receiving and completing the relevant electronic consent forms, this will be followed by nurse consultation. The consultation will **incur the cost of a consultation which is £225.**

Embryo Recipient cycle

Embryos are occasionally donated by couples who do not wish to use them for their own treatment or can be created using an egg donor and either intended parent sperm or donor sperm. The complexity of this treatment and various options need to be discussed on an individual basis and costed treatment plans will be tailored to your individual requirements. You will have the opportunity to go through each step with a clinician and given time to consider your options before an invoice will be created.

All fees must be paid in advance. Treatment fees must be cleared prior to a treatment protocol being prepared. Refunds will be made within 15 working days after cancellation of egg recovery or if no embryos for transfer.

Sperm Donor Recipient Cycle

You will need to have a consultation and all investigations undertaken as noted above with medical and nursing staff before commencing a treatment cycle. You will also have at least one consultation with our counsellor. The maximum number of cycles we provide is six, thereafter we will offer a consultation to consider your options. Our Andrology staff will help you obtain the most appropriate samples with you for your treatment which you will need to purchase outwith the Centre.
