

Prices for treatment undertaken between 1st August 2022 and 31st March 2023

Thank you for considering having your fertility treatment with us.

Before you begin any treatment, a clinical treatment plan must be agreed with you; this will be done during your consultation with one of our fertility specialists.

Since there is no standard 'one size fits all' treatment plan, costs of all possible components that make up the range of services we offer are detailed below. At your consultation with a fertility specialist, the treatment plan you agree will be made up of some, but not all, of those components listed below.

Broadly speaking, costs associated with your treatment can be grouped into the cost of:

- Consultation(s) with a fertility specialist
- Investigations
- Screening tests
- Your treatment(s)
- Medication(s)
- Storage of eggs, sperm or embryos.

Consultation

The fertility specialist will prepare for your consultation by reviewing your medical history and any tests already undertaken. They will gather further information in the consultation appointment and a letter will be sent to you outlining what was discussed and what plan has been put in place. The appointment will not be longer than 30 minutes and may be either face to face or via video link. Any investigations and/or screening tests required will be discussed with you and arranged thereafter. We may have to ask you to attend a community-based centre for blood tests- this will reduce the number of visits required to the centre.

Should you wish to commence treatment, you will be sent a link to information modules and electronic consent forms which you can complete in the comfort of your own home. You may be given a further consultation with medical staff followed by a consultation with a member of the nursing team; alternatively, you may only need a nurse appointment. The nurse appointment costs are included in the price list below.

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Treatment - IVF/ICSI Refund

We do not provide any refund should you fail to reach egg recovery.

Should your IVF cycle be cancelled *after* egg recovery, and there are no embryos to transfer, you will receive a refund of £1,210.

Should all embryos be frozen due to the risk of hyper-stimulation, we will proceed with a Frozen Embryo Transfer cycle as soon as possible at no extra cost.

Treatment- Frozen Replacement Cycle (FET)

If your FET is following a recent fresh cycle, then all information regarding the FET will be discussed with you. A link to relevant information and consent forms will be sent to be read and completed prior to a nurse consultation which is free of charge.

Treatment- Embryo Recipient cycle

Embryos are occasionally donated by couples who do not wish to use them for their own treatment or can be created using an egg donor and either intended parent sperm or donor sperm. The complexity of this treatment and various options needs to be discussed on an individual basis and a costed treatment plan will be tailored to your individual requirements. You will have the opportunity to go through each step with a clinician and given time to consider your options before an invoice will be created.

Treatment- Sperm Donor Recipient Cycle

You will need to have a consultation and all investigations undertaken as noted above with medical and nursing staff before commencing a treatment cycle. You will also have at least one consultation with our counsellor. The maximum number of cycles we provide is six, thereafter we will offer a consultation to consider your options. Our Andrology staff will help you obtain the most appropriate samples with you for your treatment which you will need to purchase out with the Centre.

Treatment- Known Sperm Donation

The recipient will be asked to pay for each stage in the known donor process. Each recipient cycle will be costed as above whether natural insemination, superovulation, or IVF cycle.
